Your Committee is still trying to organise a speaker for our July Meeting - full details will either be in our July 5&9 or via an e mail.



REPORT ON OUR MAY MEETING

"Transmitter Audio" by Terry (G4CHD)

There was a modest attendance for this short talk on how to set up the transmit audio on most modern transmitters.

Terry first compared dynamic (moving coil), capacitance and electret microphone technologies before describing the sequence adopted to set the audio. This involved setting the microphone gain (having selected your preferred mic and style of use),



followed by any compression level, then transmitter

bandwidth, and finally setting the mic equaliser.

After some discussion it was decided not to collect the Club marquee from Mike but for Terry (G4CHD) to purchase a 'self erecting' 3m x 3m Events Tent from Argos.

The weather on the day was superb and propagation conditions were better than expected. Over 5 hours operating the pile ups on the same frequency, 111 contacts were made ie approx a contact every 3 minutes.




Many thanks to those members who attended and helped erect the antenna and tent, operate and log, and chat to the public.
