EDITORIAL

This month's **Meeting on October 17**th is a Zoom talk by **Steve (G3ZPS)** entitled **Old Ham Radio Kit** – **Why the Hell do we Bother?** which will be shown at the Appledore Football Clubhouse which will open from 7.30pm so that members can grab a cuppa and have a chat before the Zoom talk which will start at 8pm.



During the weekend of September 24/25th the Club put on a special event station for the Railways on the Air weekend from the Bideford Railway Station at East the Water with the callsign GB4BHR (Bideford Heritage Railway).



The station operated on both Saturday and Sunday from approx 10am to 4pm from a railway carriage built in York back in 1956. Over the weekend operating only on 40m using the Club's IC-7410 feeding an Inverted V antenna, 288 contacts were made - a contact approx every two and half minutes.

Contacts were made with :- Norway, Germany, Belgium, Netherlands, France, Scotland, Wales, and Ireland - the rest being in England. 18 of the 36 special Railways on the Air stations were worked. Many thanks to those members who came and helped although at times more help would have been most welcome - particularly when stripping down the station at the end of Sunday operating.

The Railway Management were delighted with our Club's operation over the weekend and would be interested in discussing further Railways on the Air activations subject to the Club wishing to participate. It is therefore down to the membership to decide whether they want the Club to participate in this or similar activations in the future.

In **November** our Chairman **Mike** (**G4KXQ**) will be giving another of his excellent talks - this time on the 'uSDX - SDR transceiver' which I'm sure will be a full house so come along and grab a seat for an entertaining evening.

On **January 16th**, there will be an **Open Meeting** ie family and friends are most welcome, when **Nick Arnold** will give a talk on the **'Battle of Northam'** which will be most interesting and well worth making a note of in the diary.
